



## COVID GUIDELINES

During these uncertain times, client and staff safety is still our number one priority. The staff at Bella Vita will be sanitizing all surfaces in between each and every client. This will include *all* surfaces that anyone has come in contact with. All staff has been certified in additional and updated Barbicide infection control. We have also obtained the services of a professional sanitizing company; they will come in each week to do a deep clean and deep sanitizing of the *entire* salon and spa. Moreover, a professional air purifier will be running at all times. Please read our guidelines below.

### APPOINTMENT GUIDELINES FOR BELLA VITA (AS OF MAY 26TH):

- \* Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed on premises (staff members and guests alike)
- \* Guests will be served by appointment only
- \* Guests must provide a valid credit card upon booking for contactless payment
- \* Guest will call the salon upon arrival of appointment and wait in car until "OK'd" to come in
- \* The number of guests on premises will be limited to 50% of normal capacity
- \* Guests are required to bring and wear a protective facemask
- \* 1 guest per service provider at a time
- \* Waiting area and refreshment bar will be closed off
- \* Stations will be at least six feet apart
- \* Employees will wear protective facemasks
- \* All equipment used by a service provider will be sanitized between guests
- \* Each guest will receive a cleaned and sanitized cape
- \* Guests must wash their hands or use sanitizer upon entering the salon
- \* Doors and exits will be sanitized
- \* Due to the drastic increase in supplies, there has been a slight increase in the cost of services

We must all do our part to prevent the spread of illness in our community. You can help by staying home/rescheduling your appointment if you are feeling sick. Symptoms can appear 2–14 days after exposure and include fever, cough, and shortness of breath.
